With the audience watching from the street, I stepped inside historic photographs of the early days of the civil rights movement enlarged and projected onto vacant storefront and art gallery windows. Jackie: president Kennedy's assassination through the eyes of his wife, inspired by the gestures captured on the infamous Zapruder film, and using a 16mm projector for sound and light

Fat: Short story by Raymond Carver. 156 slices of Wonder Bread, a bowl of butter and a story told verbatim Rosa: one woman's journey through shadow and light. Projected historic photographs with self inserted as shadow

Red Coats: Short story by David James Duncan. A child's shopping nightmare. A dance with a ten-foot hanging coat
